We utilize an innovative modality that incorporates strategies like mindfulness to facilitate lasting change in behaviors. Our holistic approach stresses the importance of treating the whole person (mind, body, spirit), not merely the condition.

FAQ'S

WHAT'S AN OVI?

You may be familiar with terms like DUI (Driving Under the Influence) or DWI (Driving While Intoxicated) to describe a drunk driving offense. The current term used in Ohio is OVI (Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence).

CAN I GET A SAME-DAY APPOINTMENT?

Often times you will be able to get a same-day appointment. We also offer telemed and weekend/evening appointments.

HOW LONG DOES THE MOP LAST?

Our program is individualized and duration depends upon your progress and specific needs. The MOP lasts a minimum of 8 weeks.

HOW OFTEN DO I HAVE TO ATTEND COUNSELING SESSIONS.

Everyone engaged in the MOP attends sessions 2-5 times per week, depending on their specific needs.

WILL MEDICAID PAY FOR THIS PROGRAM?

Yes. Medicaid covers 100% of outpatient treatment costs.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE INSURANCE?

We offer a sliding fee discount for those with no insurance or out of network.
